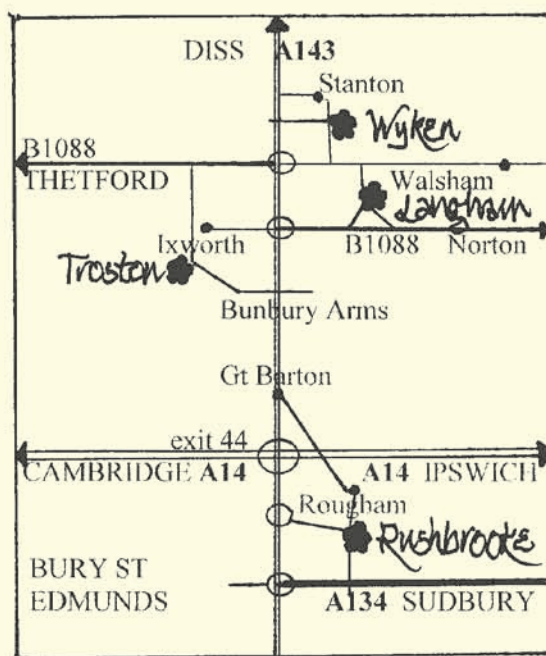

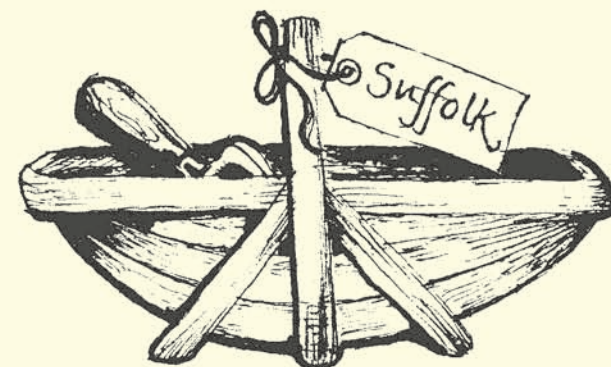

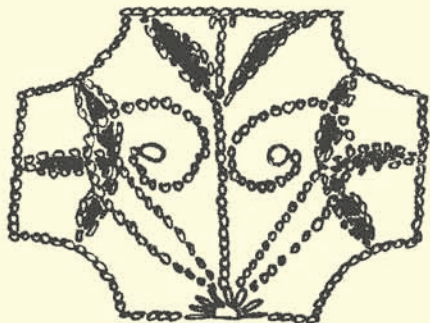

## WYKEN VINEYARDS THE LEAPING HARE

Wyken Hall Stanton IP31 2DW

*Follow the brown signs*

Like many Elizabethan manor houses, Wyken Hall is a hodge-podge of periods: 1570, 1640 and 1920, the year Sir Kenneth Carlisle's cousin bought the estate. Each generation has added something, but it was the present family that created a 4 acre garden that surrounds the house like a ruff. The series of garden rooms include a herb and knot garden, rose garden, tapestry maze, kitchen garden and, for the young at heart, a Millenium Giant Stride.
